As I write, it is planting season around here. My wife, the gardener in our family, has been planting fruits and veggies while I have been helping tend fences, move a few plants and bushes, and generally prepping for the growing season.

I have been so thankful for the (finally!) arrival of spring, even after the storm damage that many of us experienced in May. As the sun warms and the buds have popped, the trees finally sound like trees when the breeze whistles through and the grass finally sounds and smells like grass in the evening.

A few weeks ago, the frogs all decided it was time to wake up and start singing. I kept the windows open that evening to listen.

This rhythm, this season, has caused me to consider what season we are in as the Body of Christ. Like Ecclesiastes says: "¹ For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven"

What season is it for you? In your life of faith, and also in your life of work and home- what season is it? With pandemic restrictions mostly lifted, I have seen many jump right back in and pick up all the things they had set down. Scrambling madly, playing catch up. Others I have seen continue in a different pace, focusing on time at home, or with family and friends. Some I have seen remain isolated even though others long to see them. I have seen some jump into social

events only to find themselves easily exhausted. And so, I ask you again – what season is it for you?

The Christian life is a life lived asking the big question, "As God loves me, how then shall I live and love others?" The logistics of this matter. This lifestyle benefits from reflection, intentional actions, and a human pace that allows for rest and silence. Is it time to re-create busy rhythms of the past or is it time to slow down with intention? Is it time to remain isolated for simplicity, or is it time to reconnect? Is it time to plant? Time to rest?

The garden this year is going to be, and already is lovely. I have been sitting out there just to enjoy the quiet. Our work last year has paid off and it looks to be a good year behind the deer fencing. What will the summer season bring for you? Have you reflected or prayed about it? What might God desire for you? Can you engage it? I encourage you to consider how you might best live so that you are able to love others, and yourself and family in compassionate and gracious ways!
