Field Notes: Rev. C. Richards

I was out in a snowstorm this morning. I clicked into my cross-country skis, fell a few times going down the hill towards the river, and then did the hard work of breaking a trail. Much of the snow down by the river had a hard crust that only sometimes held me up. Each time I broke through one leg would fall a foot or more. With pines on either side, juniper and buckthorn, I kept working. For a mile with snow falling thick, I broke through and slid, and broke through and slid again; stopping a few times to catch my breath as the occasional rabbit hurried for cover. After completing the loop, I stopped and looked back.

The trail behind me showed all my effort snaking away into the wood. Step after step, pole holes deep on either side, snow was already beginning to fill the ridges. As I began moving again, the trail allowed me to glide and actually ski. The second loop took one-third the time that the first mile had. It was peaceful, quiet, and I was able to look up and enjoy the snowy trees. Tomorrow I will probably ski three or more laps, but two was more than enough with the trail-breaking. I'll need to get out there tomorrow as it supposed to snow again, and I'd like to keep the trail open so that I can keep enjoying smooth skiing for these last weeks of winter.

Lent is upon us. Ash Wednesday will have come and gone by the time you read this. Repentance is the point of Lent – and in brief, repentance is a Hebrew concept that comes to us translated through time via the Hebrew Testament "Tshuva", and the New Testament Greek "Metanoia." In Hebrew the word has the literal meaning of "return" and in Greek we have "to know again". I note this because neither word is defined as contrition, feeling bad or sorry about one's sin. While we may certainly feel guilt or frustration with ourselves on account of sin, it is not required or even included in the roots of the word itself. Instead, biblically, repentance is more

akin re-breaking a trail or starting a new one in the midst of the ruins of the old familiar trail of sin we have lived.

Breaking a trail is hard work. Starting a new habit (or breaking an old habit) is challenging. It takes dogged persistence, one slow step after another. Repentance is the same way. The step-by-step slog through deep snow leads us to an awareness of our own limits, our own failures. Step-by-step we turn again, see again, know again. We are indeed human – fallen, but beautiful and worthy of God's love. We are making our way to Jesus, and even though we fail, Jesus accomplishes forgiveness for us on the cross.

As I glide on the trail tomorrow, reclaiming it again from fresh snow, I will be thankful for each slow and painful step I made today. Falls, twists, trips, and all – each gliding step will be a gift of previous work. In the same way – our lives in Christ honor his gift to us, forgiveness, love, redemption, salvation – all achieved on the cross, all given freely, which we remember as we repent this Lent.
