¹⁶ Rejoice always, ¹⁷ pray without ceasing, ¹⁸ give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. ¹⁹ Do not quench the Spirit. ²⁰ Do not despise the words of prophets, ²¹ but test everything; hold fast to what is good; ²² abstain from every form of evil. - 1 Thessalonians 5:16-22.

Thanksgiving approaches along with the end of the Church year. Harvest is nearly complete and rain has come so that we are no longer in a drought. COVID continues to be a problem but much of our daily lives have returned to a more typical rhythm. With all of this, what does thankfulness look like as a Christian?

Because – even though many of the stressors of the last 6 months are alleviating – for which I am deeply grateful – I was also deeply grateful to God in the midst of those hardships. I thanked God every time I was able to visit the nursing home, every time I was able to share the Gospel in preaching or conversation, every time I joined our youth on an event or trip. God is good – all the time! So what does gratitude look like even when things remain difficult, or when things are improving but not yet behind us?

Martin Luther often reminded his parishioners that baptism is a daily death to sin, and a daily rebirth into the life of Jesus. This has been a great comfort to me during the hard things, but also during their diminishment.

Yes – COVID continues to be a deadly foe and a frightening risk – but vaccinations are continuing, health care workers are improving in their treatment of the disease, and individuals are choosing how to live with the disease in the public. We are figuring it out. Each day as I wash my hands, I thank God for my baptism that brought the Spirit into my life, and my life into the Spirit.

Yes – there is great political division remaining in our congregation and in our communities. But each day I have a conversation of listening and care with one of God's children, I thank God that because of my baptism – I have nothing to fear and I can freely care for others whom God loves.

Yes – the future remains murky, social media spreads misinformation and outrage, the wealthy are getting wealthier while the middle class is disappearing, the poor getting poorer. But every day as I sit down to a meal and give thanks, I remember my baptism and that God's love has provided for me specifically and will provide for me eternally.

How about you? What might it look like for you to consider your baptism and God's fulfillment of God's promises to you each day? Even in the ups and downs of this life, how might your gratitude to God change your way of life with others whom God loves?
